Summary

Seventy percent (70%) of parents/caregivers receiving family surveys responded and returned completed surveys. The aggregated results of their responses are shared in this report. The family survey results help to evaluate the effectiveness of the Enola Group Early Head Start Program's resources and services. The survey included questions regarding overall program satisfaction, the effectiveness of parenting supports, school readiness and child learning opportunities, and satisfaction with staff capacity-building help giving practices. Parents and caregivers had the opportunity to provide feedback about home-based and center-based services and resources, comment on playgroups, socializations, and parenting education events, and provide examples of their experiences with the Early Head Start program and staff.


Demographics





The following charts reflect the demographic information for survey respondents.






The above graph shows the employment status of survey respondents as well as the employment status of partners/spouses of the two parent households.

One hundred percent (100%) of parents and caregivers who responded are "almost always" or "always" satisfied with the Enola Group Early Head Start.





Parent Survey Topics

Survey questions covered topics such as parenting priorities and needs, personal well-being, everyday parenting experiences, school readiness and child development, and interactions with Early Head start staff. Answers were rated on a 5-point Likert scale ranging from "I" (not at all) to "3" (sometimes) to "5" (always).

Survey Results

Below are the specific survey questions parents/caregivers were asked to answer. Each question is listed along with the aggregated percentage of respondents' answers.

Question: If you needed any of the following, how well do you feel you would be able to get the help you want or need on the following topics?

An average of 85% of responding parents/caregivers reported being "a lot" or "always" confident and competent in accomplishing everyday parenting responsibilities.

An average of 93% of the parents/caregivers indicated that they "almost always" or "always" provide and encourage their children to participate in everyday learning opportunities and school readiness activities.
